About the Chalice Lighter Program

Chalice Lighter Programs were founded in the 1980s to tap into the energy and resources of Unitarian Universalists across the country to support our growth.

In Fall, Winter, and Spring, calls are issued to fund growth projects such as new congregation starts, adding professional staff, building new or enhanced space or implementing outreach and public relations programs.

The funds Chalice Lighters donate support MidAmerica congregations in a 13 state area. Since inception, the program has supported almost 100 congregations and given out over \$300,000 in grants.
